WOOD FINISH

Choose from four carefully selected wood finishes.



UP / WITHOUT PATINATION
The wood is planned and sanded to achieve a smooth surface. With few and smaller knots.
Storage furniture and small pieces leaves can only be made with this finish!



RL / RAW LOOK
We brush off the layer of softer wood which gives a look of wood that has been roughened by natural wear.
May contain more and larger knots.



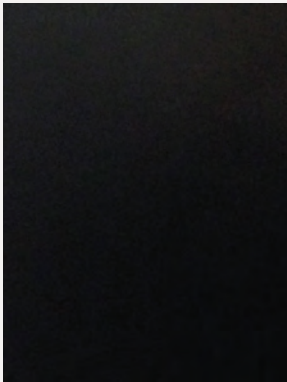
SC / SOFT CRACKS
Naturally occurring cracks are made more visible which gives a rustic look with cracks in the surface.
May contain more and larger knots.



FK / FILLED KNOTS
The knots are filled and the wood is planned and sanded to achieve a smooth surface.
Only for OAK and not possible on legs.

STEEL FINISH

Choose from two carefully selected steel finishes.



**B / BLACK
PAINTED STEEL**

Black painted steel has a graphical and simple look, that fits nicely in most homes.

Available as leg detail on bench and as handles on storage furnitures



M / BRUSHED BRASS

Brass will get natural patina over time.
Do not use water or anyother liquid when cleaning – only use a dry cloth!

Available as leg detail on dining table and bench and as handles on storage furnitures

Ant tables are available in many different sizes.

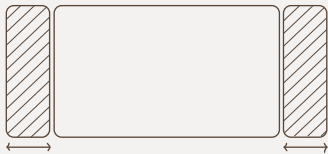

For all rectangular dining tables, you have the flexibility to add 1–2 end leaves.



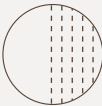
